Missions ~ Through Faith Promise we support missions in Mexico, in Sri Lanka and in South Africa. But with Helping Hands, we are supporting our neighbors right here in Roseville. Helping Hands is an organization that provides free food to any resident of Warren County. The pantry is located in the Roseville Community Center. It is open on Monday mornings from 9 to 12 and on Thursday afternoons from 3 to 6. The pantry is operated entirely by volunteers. Volunteers compose the Board, volunteers staff the pantry shifts, volunteers drive to pick up food at the food banks and volunteers unload the trucks of food when the trucks arrive. At each shift, clients come through and pick up nutritious food with the help of individual volunteers. Each family receives an amount of food proportional to the size of their family. We have a barrel in the Fellowship Hall where we donate grocery bags and canned or boxed food to Helping Hands. For the past few years, VBS has made Helping Hands its mission which introduced our children to this important local mission. Since it is volunteer run, they always need volunteers. If you are interested in volunteering, contact Amy Corman. Helping Hands needs your prayers. Please pray for the continued financial blessing of Helping Hands. Pray that more people will seek to serve on the Board and as volunteers. Many clients are elderly and in poor health. 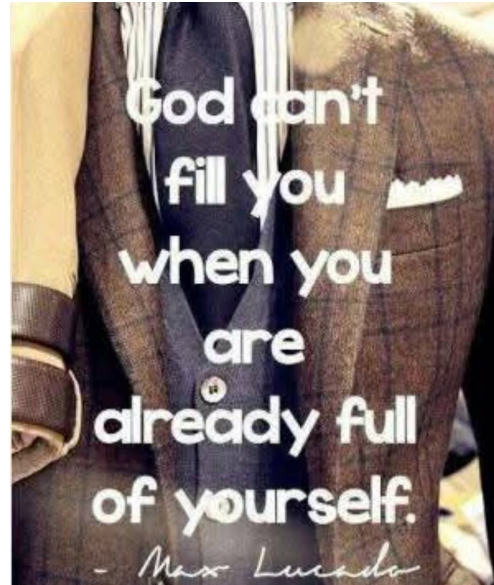

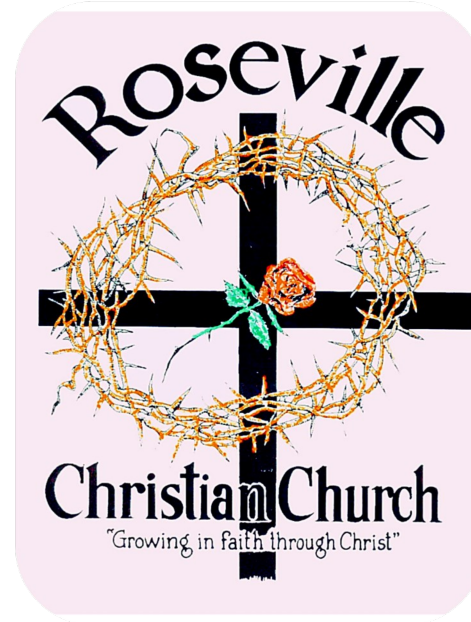
